#### VI. BUSINESS ITEMS.

#### 1. Sea Level Rise Planning Update

The City has been conducting Sea Level Rise engagement in earnest for the past four years. This engagement has led to a strategy that incorporates a measured retreat and minimal eco-armoring to preserve social and economic function in vulnerable areas over mid-term planning horizons. This plan will allow adequate time to shift uses, provide notice to landowners, and recognize the significant challenges posed by climate change.

#### RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends the Planning Commission receive a presentation on the City's Sea Level Rise strategy and public engagement to date.

## 2. Local Coastal Program Update No. 3

The City of Arcata is currently undertaking a comprehensive update to the Local Coastal Program. Staff anticipates public engagement on the document through the winter of 2020 with final hearings in spring of 2021, and certification by the Coastal Commission by the end of 2021. This business item is the third public meeting on the update to initiate public input on the draft.

Staff recommends the Planning Commission receive a report and provide a recommendation on the Local Coastal Program.
